OUR DISTRICT-WIDE NEEDS

- LEARNING SPACES: Upgrades to better support teaching and learning
- SAFETY & SECURITY: Secure entrances, separation of bus and parent drop off/pick up, security cameras, and fire alarms
- INFRASTRUCTURE & BUILDING SYSTEMS: Plumbing, HVAC, electrical, technology wiring, roofing, and windows/doors
- BUILDING CONSOLIDATION: Long-term efficiency, grade reconfiguration, and avoidance of deferred maintenance at elementary school

OUR DISTRICT-WIDE SOLUTION (NOT TO EXCEED \$20.75 MILLION)



ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

- Close and seek to sell
- Move Early Childhood 1st grade to the Intermediate School



INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL

- Change grade configuration from 2nd 6th grade to Early Childhood 6th grade
- Site improvements to separate bus and parent drop-off/pick-up areas
- Addition including classrooms and cafeteria
- Highest priority infrastructure upgrades including plumbing, HVAC, electrical, technology wiring, roofs, and windows/doors
- Learning space enhancements including flooring, lighting, cabinetry, and a larger library
- ADA compliance including a lift and door hardware
- Creation of dedicated spaces for special education classrooms



MIDDLE/HIGH SCHOOL

- Minor renovation to accommodate secure entrance
- Site and safety improvements by upgrading Hayden Road
- Science Technology Engineering & Math (STEM) expansion
- Highest priority infrastructure upgrades including roof and lighting
- ADA compliance including a lift and door hardware
- Fitness/Weight room expansion

ESTIMATED TAX IMPACT	Per Year	Per Month
\$100,000 Property Value	\$99.00	\$8.25
\$200,000 Property Value	\$198.00	\$16.50
\$300,000 Property Value	\$297.00	\$24.75
