Registration

Registration can be completed only electronically through each child's Family Access Account through Arena Scheduling beginning

April 15 through May 8.

Registration will open on April 15 at 6:00 pm. The Elementary School Library will be open from 6 - 7:30 pm on April 15 for any families who need assistance registering.

Please pay for all classes at the time of registration.

Classes that are dropped or changed will only be granted refunds up through May 31.

Steps to register for Belleville School District - Summer School 2019

Registration begins on April 15 at 6:00 p.m.

- Go to the Belleville School District website at www.belleville.k12.wi.us
- Click on the **FAMILIES** tab.
- Click on **Summer Opportunities/Summer School** listed under the tab FAMILIES. Click on the link that says **Summer School Registration**
- If you do not already have a Family Access login, please click the 'Forgot Login/Password' button from the Summer School Registration link.
- Click on **Arena Scheduling**. Click on the 2018-2019 link under your child's name. You will then be able to view available classes for your child. You will click the **ADD** button to add classes. You can also click view/print schedule near the top to review what your child has added.
- Make sure to click **Submit** when you are finished.
- Please use the grade level that your child is **currently in** for your course selections.
- For children entering 4K in the fall of 2019, use Preschool (-0) as their grade.
- You may also register for 1st Session of Swimming Lessons.
- Pool Passes and Competitive and Endurance Swim may also be purchased this year.
- Follow the directions on how to pay for your selections. This year we are offering the online payment option. Purchases may be made via efunds with a credit or debit card for a minimal fee, or payments may be made from your checking account (by providing your bank routing number and account number) as a one time withdrawal free of charge. Your selections will remain in your cart until payment is processed. **You must check out to ensure your enrollment in the class.**
- Please print your child's schedule to use on the first day of class.

SUMMER SCHOOL GENERAL INFORMATION

Calendar

Classes run Monday through Thursday. Summer School dates are:

Session 1

June 17 - July 3 (No Friday classes)

Session 2

July 22 - August 1 (No Friday classes)

**Session 1 and 2 are separate from one another. Session 2 is not a continuation of Session 1 with the exception of 'Invitation Classes' and classes listed with a Part 1 and Part 2. Parents should plan to sign their child up for different classes in Session 1 and 2.

**There are a few classes that fall outside of the two session dates. For a list of all Summer 2019 classes please refer to the Families- Summer Opportunities Tab on the School District of Belleville Website.

Arrival Time

Children should not arrive before 7:40 A.M. There is no adult supervision indoors or outside before this time.

Attendance

It is extremely important that parents contact the school if your child will not be attending classes on any given day. We realize that attendance is not mandatory, but we want to make sure all children are safe and accounted for. We will call you if your child is reported absent by the teacher. Dress and Conduct:

Students may wear casual clothing during summer school, but appropriate clothing and footwear is expected. **Sandals/flip flops are highly discouraged** due to safety concerns, especially for outdoor classes, recess, etc.

Appropriate behavior is expected from all students during summer school. Summer school staff will contact parents if behavior issues occur in the classroom, hallways, playground, etc. If problems continue, the student may be removed from the class for the remainder of the session and possibly lose the privilege of attending any summer school classes.

Fees and Payment

Courses may charge a minimum supply fee per students per course to cover all supplies. No child will be kept out of summer school because of financial hardship. If your family would like to request financial assistance, please call Brenda Gocht at 835-6120. We can help, but it is your responsibility to make the request.

**Payments for all summer school classes will be processed through E-Funds through Family Access. Please pay at the time of registration. **

Refund Policy

No refunds or credits will be given for cancellations occurring after May 31 unless the cancellation is due to a medical or family emergency. Any refunds due will be processed and issued as a credit to the School District of Belleville family food service account.

Food Service

Breakfast and Lunch will available during Summer School this year!

1. Breakfast will be available from 7:40 - 8:00 am in the Elementary School Cafeteria.
2. Lunch will be a Grab and Go option available from 11:55 - 12:15 pm
3. Students will be able to use their school lunch account to have breakfast and lunch.
4. Students who receive assistance for food service during the school year will qualify for the same assistance with the summer school food service.
5. **Students need to sign up for breakfast and/or lunch during the registration process. This will allow the cafeteria to plan ahead for the number of students planning to participate in the breakfast and lunch program.**
 - a. **Breakfast First Session: BREAK1**
 - b. **Breakfast Second Session: BREAK2**
 - c. **Lunch First Session: LUNCH1**
 - d. **Lunch Second Session: LUNCH2**

District Website

We will use the district website at www.belleville.k12.wi.us to provide you with complete information about summer school so please take the opportunity to become familiar with it. The Summer School link can be found under Families- Summer Opportunities. When you reach the Summer School page, you will find links to our Summer School Courses and a link to the Online Registration- this is through Family Access. It is a good idea to check the website regularly for updated information.

Grade Level/Age

Use your child's **current** 2018-2019 grade level to determine the appropriate summer school classes. For example, if your child is in the 3rd grade right now, then you will register him as a 3rd grader. Using the wrong grade level will delay your child's registration. The grade/age requirements are set to benefit the children and make instruction more consistent for the teacher. If a class has an age requirement, your child must be that age by the last date of the class.

Cancelled Classes

All classes must meet a minimum of 12 enrolled students in order to be held. Summer School Staff will review course enrollment numbers by May 24, 2019 and families will be notified of courses that do not meet the minimum enrollment threshold. If a course is dropped, families will have the opportunity to enroll in any course that still has seats remaining open at that time. Final determination of class offerings will be based on student enrollment and other criteria set forth by the Summer School Coordinator.

Health Concerns

The School District of Belleville will use the information you have provided to the school health staff to make teachers aware of any potential health concerns. If there is a change in your child's health status, please contact Rebecca Clark our school nurse at clarkr1@belleville.k12.wi.us

Location/Room Assignments

The majority of classes will be held at Belleville Elementary School. There are a minimal number of classes held at the Middle/High School for Middle or High School students. (For example: Fitness Classes and Credit Recovery)

Final determination of room assignments may not be posted until late May. Once we have made a final determination of classes and their room assignments we will post them on the district website.

****Our youngest students will have helpers to get them from class to class as well as to the pool and back.****

Picking Up and Dropping Off Students

1. Students who are dropped off and/or picked up for summer school should do so in the same manner as during the regular school year. They should be dropped on the North Side of the building entering near the CH gym.
2. Students who walk to summer school should use the same crosswalks used during the regular school year. Keep in mind that crossing guards are not present during summer school. They may enter through the front doors of the building at 7:40 am and go straight to the cafeteria until 7:55.

Transportation

The school district will provide transportation for students attending La Petite or Belleville Early Learning Center for first and second session. Bus service will run at 8:00 am and 12:00 pm. Students attending summer school from these two centers will need a full schedule to take advantage of transportation. (The only exception will be incoming 4K students as they only have one offering, so we will have one bus run for these students at 10:00 am.)

****We will continue to explore expanding transportation options in the future.****

Swimming Program

The School District of Belleville offers Red Cross Swimming Lessons as a part of the summer school program. Families are able to sign up for Session 1 through Family Access. Session 2 and 3 sign ups are available at the pool after opening. The following are the pool swimming lesson sessions:

- Session 1: June 11 - June 28
Session 2: July 1 - July 19 (No class on July 4)
Session 3: July 22 - August 9

****Swimming lessons run 30 minutes. A supervisor will be able to help students to and from the pool between summer school and swimming classes.****
